## Additional Editing Capabilities

### Upload an Image

1. Log in or create an account:  
<http://www.richmondwiki.org/wiki/Special:Userlogin>
2. Click on the "Upload file" link in the "toolbox" in the left sidebar, or visit the Upload file page: <http://www.richmondwiki.org/wiki/Special:Upload>
3. Click on the "Browse" button, select the desired file, and click "Ok" or "Open"
4. Add a descriptive Summary of the image

### Create a New Page

**From the Search Box:** If you search for a page that doesn't exist (using the search box and 'go' button on the left of the page) then you will be provided with a link to create the new page.

**Using the URL:** Visit the **ARTICLE** page by using this URL:  
<http://www.RichmondWiki.org/wiki/ARTICLE>. If you replace **ARTICLE** with the name of the page you wish to create, you will be taken to a blank page which indicates that no article of that name exists yet. Clicking the "edit" page tab at the top of the page will take you to the edit page for that article, where you can create the new page by typing your text, and clicking Save Page.
